### Introductory note

#### **This introductory note does not form a part of the notice.**

Under the Environmental Permitting (England & Wales) Regulations 2010 (schedule 5, part 1, paragraph 19) a variation may comprise a consolidated permit reflecting the variations and a notice specifying the variations included in that consolidated permit.

Schedule 1 of the notice specifies the conditions that have been varied and schedule 2 comprises a consolidated permit which reflects the variations being made. All the conditions of the permit have been varied and are subject to the right of appeal.

The activities covered by this permit are now limited to waste operations; therefore the attached consolidated permit is a waste permit.

As a result of this variation Activity A1 (S5.4 A1 (a)(iii), production of Refuse Derived Fuel (RDF) from residual waste) and its directly associated activities (Activities A3, A4 and A5) are removed from the permit. The operator will no longer be using a specific item of equipment to treat RDF to improve fuel quality. The remaining RDF treatment activities fall within the terms of existing materials recycling facility operations.

This variation also amends Activity A2 (S5.4 A1 (a)(iii), production of RDF from waste wood) and removes its directly associated activities (A3 and A5). This activity is no longer considered to be within the scope of the "pre-treatment of waste for incineration or co-incineration" activity. The production of RDF from waste wood will be regulated as a waste operation this has been added to the revised Table S1.1.

As a result of this variation Table S1.1 has been amended to include the following activities:

- Treatment of non-hazardous waste wood for the production of a refuse derived fuel (now activity A1)
- Material recovery facility (MRF) (now activity A2)
- Waste transfer station (now activity A3)
- Concrete crushing facility (now activity A4)

In addition to the above changes requested by the operator, we have also added the requirement to undertake ambient air monitoring for particulate matter (PM10). Tables S3.2, S4.1 and S4.2 have been added to reflect this requirement.

The schedules specify the changes made to the permit.
