Powerday recognises that in carrying out its principal operations - waste management, recycling alternative fuel production and construction – the company will inevitably impact on the environment and is committed to minimise the potentially harmful effects of such operations wherever and whenever possible.

To emphasise the above commitment, the Company has developed a comprehensive Policy Statement which will guide all of our operations. This policy statement enables us to set objectives for sustainable, environmental improvement which can be measured and monitored regularly and in turn, contribute to prevention of pollution and future protection of the environment.

The environmental management system is subject to external verification to demonstrate compliance with ISO14001:2015 where such standards are in operation.

All employees are encouraged to understand and implement the objectives of this policy in their day to day work through regular discussion, communication and training. The Chief Executive has specific responsibilities for policy development, co-ordination and evaluation of performance.

The Company is committed to minimising the impact of its operations on the environment. In particular, Powerday will:

- Ensure appropriate resources are made available to ensure the environmental policy is implemented in full
- Discuss environmental issues with all employees, conduct training programmes and encourage best implementation practice by all personnel
- Meet and where appropriate, exceed the requirements of all relevant legislation and where no regulations exist, we shall set our own exacting standards
- Work with our suppliers and sub-contractors to minimise the impact of their operations on the environment through a proactive procurement dialogue
- Seek to reduce the consumption of materials in all operations, re-using rather than disposing wherever possible and promoting recycling and the use of recycled materials
- Whenever and wherever practicable reduce the level of pollution and harmful emissions, noise, visual and other impacts on the local environment
- Regularly review and monitor environmental performance to ensure our environmental objectives and targets as described above are maintained at all times
