WHEREAS the London Waste Regulation Authority on 18 January 1994 granted a Waste Disposal Licence No. DL167 (which on 1st May 1994 became a Waste Management Licence) to Economic Excavations (skips) Limited subsequently transferred to Economic Skips Limited on 23 July 1999 relating to the waste transfer facility at Mercury Way, London subject to the conditions set out therein and modification to these conditions set out in the Notice dated 23 July 1999.

AND WHEREAS on 26 July 2001 you applied to the Environment Agency to modify the said conditions,

NOW THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY HEREBY GIVES YOU NOTICE of modifying the said conditions as shown on the attached schedule.

Conditions 4.4.1, 5.1.1 and 7.7 are modified pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 37(1)(b)

Conditions 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 are deleted and condition 11.0 is added pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1990 Section 37(1)(a)

RIGHTS OF APPEAL.

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the Secretary of State,

- (c) the conditions of a licence are modified,

the applicant may appeal from the decision to the Secretary of State

Therefore if you feel aggrieved by the decision or any of the conditions to the licence as granted you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give written notice of an appeal from:-

This notice of appeal should be accompanied by the following information: a copy of the licence; a copy of any correspondence relevant to the appeal; a copy of any other document relevant to the appeal including, in particular, any relevant consent, determination, notice, planning permission, established use certificate or certificate of lawful use or development; and a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations. You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency, Swift House, Frimley Business Park, Camberley, Surrey, GU16 7SQ. You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the Secretary of State may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.

Substitute the following in accordance with section 5 of the working plan.

LICENCE CONDITION 7.7 is amended as follows:

Delete words located in the position shown on drawing Reg. No. LWRA/378410, holder's drawing No. 101A dated 28.10.92

Add words at end of condition in accordance with sections 3.2 and 9.4 of the working plan

NEW LICENCE CONDITION 11.0 is added:-**11.0 Amendments to working plan and supporting information is added:***Amendments to the working plan requiring prior consent by the Agency*

11.1.1 The Licence Holder shall give the Agency prior notice in writing of any proposed change to those sections of the working plan which are specified in Table 11.0 below, and to any appendices, drawings and figures which are referenced in those sections.

- 11.1.2 The notice shall be accompanied by a copy of the proposed changes, and by a written assessment of the effect that implementing the proposed change to the working plan would have on the risk posed by the site to human health and the environment.
- 11.1.3 The Licence Holder shall provide up to 6 additional copies of the proposed change and supporting risk assessment to the Agency, when required by the Agency in writing.
- 11.1.4 The proposed change to the working plan shall not be implemented unless the Agency has given its written consent to it. Following consent, the Licence Holder shall give the Agency prior written notification of the implementation date of the change, and from that date the changed section shall be deemed to be incorporated in the working plan in replacement of the previous version of that section.

Amendments to the working plan requiring prior notification to the Agency

- 11.2.1 Except where it is specified under condition 11.1.1 above that the amendment of specified sections of the working plan requires the prior consent of the Agency, the Licence Holder shall give the Agency not less than 7 days prior written notice of any change to the working plan and to any appendices, drawings and figures which are referenced from those sections.
- 11.2.2 The notice shall be accompanied by a copy of the specified changes.
- 11.2.3 The Licence Holder shall provide up to 6 additional copies of the proposed change to the Agency, when required by the Agency in writing.
- 11.2.4 Such changes to the working plan shall be deemed to be incorporated in the working plan and implemented on the date specified to the Agency in the amendment notification.
